INBETWEENNESS: THE RESONATING SPIRITUAL DIMENSION OF INTERSUBJECTIVITY

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Inbetweenness is a shared resonating spiritual dimension which is unseen and unheard yet is deeply experienced in interpersonal relationships where authenticity characterizes the way that two or more persons are together.

In the heart of *Inbetweenness* two or more person's spiritual dimensions intermingle and a new dimension emerges in each that did not exist prior to coming together in this way.

The shared spiritual dimension is a central energizing quality and provides a sense of protection, support and caring.

The new dimension which emerges involves an infinite spiritual as well as human spiritual dimension and together, each person can go where neither alone could go.

Each person in the relationship takes the other person forward in life, through both good and bad times and together they enjoy an interpersonal transcendence which enlivens, enriches and engenders compassion, care and solicitude.

The spiritual dimensions in each person resonate and harmonize together, reverberating and in so doing,

set up a resonant field of dynamic unity
within which each person finds empathy, understanding and deep care.

The interpersonal transcendence
also frees each person to more fully be oneself.

It encourages each person to learn more
and comprehension grows while understanding and empathy deepens.

The liberating quality found in *Inbetweenness*
opens new possibilities for each person
and is given back mutually so that each brings the other forward.

When taken all together the qualities found
in this way of being oneself
with the other as a part of the other
in an essential and meaningful way,
continues to develop, deepen and grow
until
if one person in the relationship is gone,
a part of oneself is experienced as also being gone.

This is the dimensional arc of
Inbetweenness.

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
